

Entering Social Networking Strategy ("SNS")

<u>Social Networking Strategy</u> is a peer-driven approach to recruitment that involves identifying persons living with HIV or persons who engage in behaviors that put them at risk of HIV infection from the community to serve as "Recruiters." Recruiters deliver key messages and encourage HIV testing among individuals within their social, sexual, or drug-using networks who are persons who engage in behaviors that put them at risk of HIV infection. These individuals are known as the Recruiter's Network Associates (NA) and are people with whom the Recruiter has an existing relationship.

Please note that the data entry workflow differs for Recruiters and Network Associates as indicated below

Entering Social Networking Strategy for Recruiters

Contracts funded to provide Social Networking Strategy are required to document and enter the following services for **all Recruiters**:


- 1. program enrollment;
- 2. service encounter information within the corresponding AIRS Service Encounter module;
- 3. HIV testing encounters within the AIRS CTR module;
- 4. STI screening (if applicable) as a service encounter within the Primary Care / Initial Visit service category;
- 5. rapid HCV testing (if applicable) within the HCV module; and
- 6. program disenrollment


Program Enrollment

All recruiters are required to be **enrolled** in the AIRS program performing SNS. The process for enrolling clients depends on whether the individual is brand new to your agency or is an existing client.

Clients who are brand new to your agency may be enrolled through the Agency Intake screen



Clients who have previously received services at your agency can be enrolled from the Program
 Enrollments screen (under the Enrollments/Assignments module) as of the date they were screened as
 a recruiter


Social Networking Strategy

HIV Testing Encounters

- Enter HIV testing <u>under the program performing SNS</u> as indicated on the AIRS <u>How To: AIRS</u>
 <u>Counseling, Testing, and Referrals (AIRS CTR) video</u> on <u>AIRSNY.org</u>
- Enter a Social Networking Strategy encounter (as described <u>above</u>) that includes the service HIV Rapid Testing (995)
 - Note: this does not need to be a stand-alone encounter. If multiple services are provided on one day they should all be entered on one encounter

STI Service Encounters

- Enter STI Services <u>under the program performing SNS</u> as indicated on the AIRS <u>How To: Entering</u>
 "Sexually Transmitted Infections" (STI) Lab Tests guidance document on AIRSNY.org
- Enter a Social Networking Strategy encounter (as described <u>above</u>) that includes the service Other Testing – STD (590)
 - Note: this does not need to be a stand-alone encounter. If multiple services are provided on one day they should all be entered on one encounter

HCV Testing Encounters

- Enter HCV testing as indicated on the AIRS <u>How To: How to use the Hepatitis Screens in AIRS video</u> on <u>AIRSNY.org</u>
- Enter a Social Networking Strategy encounter (as described <u>above</u>) that includes the service Other
 Testing Viral Hepatitis (592)
 - Note: this does not need to be a stand-alone encounter. If multiple services are provided on one day they should all be entered on one encounter



Program Disenrollment

Once the formal relationship with the Recruiter has ended, enter a program disenrollment using one of the approved Reason Codes

In the Program Enrollments screen (under the Enrollments/Assignments module) end the recruiters
enrollment in the program performing SNS as of the date their participation in the program ended using
one of the approved reason codes

Entering Social Networking Strategy for Network Associates (NA)


Contracts funded to provide Social Networking Strategy are required to document and enter the following services for all Network Associates:

- 1. program enrollment;
- 2. HIV testing encounters within the AIRS CTR module;
- 3. STI screening (if applicable) as a service encounter within the Primary Care / Initial Visit service category;
- 4. rapid HCV testing (if applicable) within the HCV module; and
- 5. program disenrollment

Program Enrollment

All Network Associates are required to be enrolled in the AIRS program performing SNS

 In the Program Enrollments screen (under the Enrollments/Assignments module) enroll the client in the program performing SNS as of the date of their CTR encounter


HCV Testing Encounters

 Enter HCV testing <u>under the program performing SNS</u> as indicated on the AIRS <u>How To: How to use</u> the Hepatitis Screens in AIRS video on <u>AIRSNY.org</u>

Program Disenrollment

Once data entry for CTR (and, if applicable, STI/HCV) has been entered, enter a program disenrollment using one of the approved Reason Codes

- In the Program Enrollments screen (under the Enrollments/Assignments module) end the Network Associates enrollment in the program
- The reason code for Network Associate program disenrollments will always be <u>Completed</u>
 <u>Therapy/Service (14)</u>
